

Winter Wonderland Beanie Pattern

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What You'll Need:

Size N (9.00 mm) hook

Size I (6.00 mm) hook

Bulky Weight Yarn for the hat

Medium Worsted Weight Yarn for the snowflake

Stitches and Abbreviations You'll Need to Know:

ch – chain

rnd – round

ch sp – chain space

sl st – slip stitch

sc – single crochet

hdc – half double crochet

dc – double crochet

dtr – double treble crochet

Picot – (ch3, sl st in top of previous st)

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Snowflake Instructions:

With worsted weight yarn (I used JoAnn Sensations Sincerely White) and size I (6.00mm) hook.

ch 12, sls st in 1st ch to create a loop

Rnd 1) ch 3, sl st in center loop, *ch3, sl st in center loop, repeat from * 10 more times, sl st in first ch sp of the rnd.

Rnd 2) ch 1, sc in same ch sp, picot (ch 3, sl st in top of sc), sl st in same ch sp. In next ch sp: sl st, ch 1, dc, ch1, dtr, picot (ch 3, sl st in top of dtr), ch 1, dc, ch 1, sl st. *In next ch sp: sl st, ch 1, sc, picot, ch 1 sl st. In next ch sp: sl st, ch 1, dc, ch1, dtr, picot, ch 1, dc, ch 1, sl st. Repeat from * 5 more times, sl st in back of snowflake at the end. Finish off and sew in ends.

Pretty Chunky Beanie:

With bulky yarn (I used Deborah Norville Serenity Chunky Yarn in Red Ochre) and size N (9.00mm) hook.

ch 3, sl st to join and create a loop

Rnd 1) ch 2, 2dc in center loop, ch 1, *3dc, ch 1, repeat from * 2 times, sl st in ch sp before first dc.

Rnd 2) sl st in next 2 dc, sl st in ch sp, ch 2, 2dc in ch sp, ch 1, 3dc in same ch sp, ch 1, *3 dc in next ch sp, ch 1, 3dc in same ch sp, ch 1, repeat from * 2 times, sl st in ch sp before first dc of rnd.

Rnd 3) sl st in next 2 dc, sl st in ch sp, ch 2, 2dc in same ch sp, ch 1, 3dc in next ch sp, ch 1, 3dc in same ch sp, ch 1, *3dc in next ch sp, ch 1, 3dc in next ch sp, ch 1, 3dc in same ch sp, ch 1, repeat from *2 times, st st in ch sp before first dc of rnd.

Rnd 4) sl st in next 2 dc, sl st in ch sp, ch 2, 2dc in same ch sp, ch 1, *3dc in next ch sp, ch 1, repeat from * 10 more times, sl st in ch sp before first dc.

Rnd 5-8) repeat rnd 4.

Rnd 9) ch 1, hdc in next st and in each st across, sl st in first hdc of rnd. Finish off and sew in ends.
